

New composite decking

It was a big decision to move away from timber decking and opt for composite decking on park. This decision was made a lot easier by knowing that:

- 95% of the new decking is made from up-cycled materials.
- The boards will not splinter, rot or split.
- It will not need sanding or sealing unlike timber.
- Low potential for slipping in either wet or dry.

It is manufactured from reclaimed hardwood and polymer from recycled polyethylene, typically plastic milk bottles. Less energy is used for the manufacture than for recycled plastic decking resulting in less carbon emissions. The composite decking also has an in-built resistance to moisture eliminating the need for stains or sealants so there will be no nasty chemicals to leach into the soil or lake.

The product has achieved FSC® and PEFC certification meaning customers can be assured that all the wood fibres used come from sustainable and well managed forests.

2018 Calendar

The return of the Pearl Lake calendar is imminent. We have received a lot of photos from you but there is still time to submit that last minute magic moment captured on or around the park. If you do have a special shot that for you sums up everything about why you come here - it might be the people, or the scenery, the lake, the villages, the golf or fishing, the wildlife, the serenity - then please get a high resolution digital copy to Rob (office) as soon as possible.



It's that time of year again when we are still cutting the grass regularly but the as the weather is getting wetter, both with morning dew and rainfall, any grass cuttings can easily and unintentionally be trailed around the park. This is most evident at the entrance / exit to the golf course. We have placed a cleaning brush near the first tee to make it easier to clean shoes and trolley wheels as you leave the course. Please make use of the brush and it will keep the road cleaner from the course and past the Lakeside.

Talking of grass (I'm on a roll now!) obviously the ground on park is softer overall and much more susceptible to car / tyre damage if driven upon. If you find the road blocked temporarily please find another road to bypass the obstruction or wait until you can drive past without driving on the grass. For the short amount of time it can add to your day it will save the team on park a huge amount of time in repairs and maintenance.

We are proud of everyone on park and your determination to recycle household waste where possible. We use Quickskip in Hereford because of their record and approach to recycling responsibly. They are committed to reducing landfill waste by recycling and processing all of our skip waste, operating a dedicated recycling centre at Rotherwas in Hereford to process all waste collected in our skips. The team at Rotherwas process over 150 tons of general waste per day, separating, processing and sorting to reduce waste going to landfill. They reclaim stone, soil, metals, wood, cardboard, paper, plastics and garden waste. Even though Quickskip separate everything at their depot we follow David Bellamy Award guidelines to have individual bins for the job.

Talking of recycling (nice segway) there is a trailer behind the Lakeside for green/garden waste. There should be no bags in the trailer. Please empty all waste into the trailer and dispose of the bags accordingly as all green waste is composted.

Just a quick reminder to keep any flower pots and garden ornaments on the slabs and far enough away from the edge so that the park mowing can continue uninterrupted, thank you.
